

## Enhanced Troop Weekend FAQ's

**Can units come during the week/weekend and not participate in the Enhanced weekend?** No

**Can we camp there and not participate in anything that Camp Durant has going on?**

Camp will not be open to units not participating in our Enhanced Troop Campouts

**Can a troop stay past Sunday?**

Yes, but they can only stay until Tuesday. We need to give the camp a deep cleaning and time to rest before the next groups come in.

**Can units use the Camp program resources after Sunday if someone in the unit has the certifications?**

Unfortunately, no we are having multiple units want to stay for the extra time. Multiple units have already asked for the same resources on the same weekend. We must minimize contact between groups.

**Is Camp Durant available to utilize in June for Troop camping?**

No, we are minimizing the exposure before camp.

**Will Social Distancing be in effect?** Yes

**Does our Troop have to participate in one Merit Badge as a group?**

No, each unit will be allotted a certain number of slots per Merit Badge.

**If I have 10 Scouts and each one wants to take a different Merit Badge is that acceptable?** Yes

**Will my Scouts be in Merit Badge with Scouts from other Troops?** Yes, this is the only time units will be mingled. The Merit Badge session will be all day. CDC guidance is to minimize mixing of groups.

**Is this basically one Merit Badge per weekend?**

No, we are suggesting that each troop to come prepared to instruct Cooking, Camping MB, 1<sup>st</sup> year Scout skills or any other that the Troop wants to.

**Will all 10 Merit Badges be offered every weekend?**

Yes, and we may be offering more than what is on this list because we have had some volunteers offer to instruct other sessions. We will know more as we get closer to the weekends.

**Regarding YPT tenting requirements where we are supposed to use the buddy system – it will not be possible to maintain 6' of social distancing having 2 scouts in a 2-man tent – will this be relaxed for camping at Durant?**

The guidance we have received is the following: Scouts sleep head to toe when sharing a tent, or one person to a tent, or one person to a hammock. The buddy system will be in effect as much as possible; when scouts get signed up for Merit Badges, try to sign up 2 if possible. If Scouts go to different sessions, they will stay together as long as possible before separating.

**What about Part C with the Health Form?**

Part C only applies to unit activities greater than 72 hours. Part C of the AHMR is valid for 6 months if completed on or after February 1, 2019. Alternate exams can be accepted when signed by Doctor.

### **What about refunds?**

If the weekend session/sessions are canceled due to State/Federal/Local restrictions related to COvid-19, everyone will be receiving a full refund. The refund policy for summer camp will be our primary reference with the date changed to July 1.

As of July 1, 2020, registration fees are **NOT REFUNDABLE** unless there are extenuating circumstances totally beyond the control of the Scout which result in their inability to attend Camp Durant.

Reasons such as vacation schedule, sports, work, other camps and last-minute changes of mind are not acceptable reasons for refunds.

In cases of death of an immediate family member, sickness/injury, military transfer or summer school the Unit must present documentation verifying the extenuating circumstances by a third party (i.e., doctor, military officer or school principal) to receive a refund.

A Refund Request Form must be filled out and turned in during the Check-Out Process in the Administration Building before the end of the weekend.

Refund Checks will be issued to the Treasurer listed on the Refund Request Form within 30 days after the end of your camp weekend.
